At United Way of Greater Kansas City, we've partnered with **H&R Block** to offer MyFreeTaxes.com, an income tax e-filing system free for households that make \$66,000 or less†. The IRS-certified and secure service offers free filing for federal and up to three state returns.

In-person assistance is also available. If you would prefer more help to complete your tax returns, United Way supports Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites throughout the metro area for qualified individuals and families.

- Social Security or Individual Taxpayer Identification numbers for each family member and working adult.
- 1095-A if you received a tax credit from the healthcare.gov marketplace.
- Childcare provider name, address and tax ID, if applicable.
- Bank routing and account numbers for checking or savings accounts (if you qualify for refund via secure direct deposit).
- Last year's tax return, if you have it.
- A valid email address.
- W-2s, 1099s, 1098s and other income forms.
- 2017 Adjusted Gross Income, in order to transmit your return.**



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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is MyFreeTaxes?

United Way partners with H&R Block to provide its Premium online tax filing software to help people easily and accurately file their federal and state taxes through MyFreeTaxes. You can easily access MyFreeTaxes.com from your computer or the palm of your hand, and can file federal and up to three state returns for free.

Who qualifies for the free tax service?

If your household made \$66,000 or less in 2018, you can file your federal and state tax returns for no charge.

What materials will I need to e-file?

- Social Security or Individual Taxpayer Identification numbers for each family member and working adult.
- 1095-A if you received a tax credit from the healthcare.gov marketplace.
- Childcare provider name, address and tax ID, if applicable.
- Bank routing and account numbers for checking or savings accounts (if you qualify for refund via secure direct deposit).
- Last year's tax return, if you have it.
- A valid email address.
- W-2s, 1099s, 1098s and other income forms.
- **2017 Adjusted Gross Income, in order to transmit your return.**

Can I import my filing data from last year?

Yes, but make sure the imported information is accurate.

What types of returns can I file on MyFreeTaxes?

Federal, all 50 states, and the District of Columbia tax returns can be filed through MyFreeTaxes. A user can file one federal and up to three state returns in one year.

Can I itemize deductions?

You can complete almost any form or schedule* in MyFreeTaxes. As long as your household Adjusted Gross Income is below \$66,000, your return is free.

When will I get my tax refund?

The IRS issues most refunds in less than 21 days after receiving your tax return, and you can track your refund status at <https://www.irs.gov/refunds>. If you are eligible for a state tax refund, check with your state's department of revenue for information on how to track that refund.

How do I get started?

1. Go to MyFreeTaxes.com.
2. On the left-hand side, click "Get Started."
3. On the page you'll be directed to, read the text at the top of the page, then click "Got it. Let's Go."
4. You will be redirected to an H&R Block screen where you can either click "Sign In" or "Create Account."
5. If you have already created an account, sign in; if you have not created an account select "Create Account."
6. Fill out the necessary information to create your account and make sure you keep your username and password in a safe place.
7. Once you have created an account click "Sign In."

* International students or anyone needing to file a 1040-NR will NOT be able to use MyFreeTaxes.com.

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
