2019 Incoming Freshman Talent Scholarship

The faculty of the Department of Fine Arts, Photo & Film recognizes that a student's growth is dependent on motivation, receptivity, exploration, and skill. To support this growth, the faculty will award an unspecified number of \$250 to \$750 scholarships every Fall for incoming freshman, deserving students. The faculty reserves the right to not award scholarships if there are not sufficient applicants or if the quality of the work submitted does not meet the criteria as listed below.

ELIGIBILITY:

Student must:

- Be a Johnson County, Kansas resident.
- Be a Johnson County High School graduating senior
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress according to the JCCC Student Financial Aid policy.
- Have a minimum cumulative 2.0 GP A.
- If awarded a scholarship, be a JCCC student and take at least one Fine Arts/Photography/Film class in the semester following receipt of the award and be enrolled in at least six hours at the college.

HOW THE AWARD IS DETERMINED:

Applicants must submit five images and/or videos of their own original artwork, which will be evaluated on the criteria below. The work must be original and not reproductions of any kind. This work may include any media or combination of mediums. All submissions are required to have the application form filled out as well as a scholarship label for each work of art. The form and labels need to be fully filled out and submitted with the works.

Faculty jurors will consider the following:

- creativity.
- strength of visual form.
- understanding of the interaction between medium and meaning.
- understanding of composition and design in connection with subject matter.
- mastery of and/or innovative use of materials.
- professional presentation.
