**TICKETS:** Tickets will be on sale May 14 - 16 during Falcon 50/lunch and on May 17<sup>th</sup> before and after Senior activities. Everyone MUST have a ticket to attend. No walk-in students will be allowed in. **\*\* NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AFTER MAY 17<sup>TH</sup> \*\***

**COST: \$25** – Cash or checks payable to OSPG (Olathe South Project Grad). All sales are final. No refunds.

**BUSES:** Buses will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Each ticket will have a corresponding bus number on it. If your student wants to be on the same bus as a friend, they should buy their tickets at the same time.

**CINCH BAGS:** OSPG will provide cinch bags for all students. The only item students will be allowed to take into Matt Ross will be a cell phone. Keys and other items will be placed in cinch bags for safe keeping and returned when they load buses to return to Olathe South.
