Delta Sigma Phi Scholarship	April 10 2010	\$500 (2 awards)	Applicants must be an incoming male freshman at Kansas State University. Scholarship will be based on leadership and academic excellence. Recipient will be under no obligation to join Delta Sigma Phi.
Go-Long Scholarship Fund	April 15 2010	Varies	High school <b>senior</b> who plans to attend a two or four year college/technical school who has demonstrated financial need. Applicant must have a minimum 2.0 GPA. Winner of this scholarship will be required to complete at least 8 hours of community service.
National Council of Jewish Women	April 15 2010	Varies	Financial need is a major consideration for this scholarship. A copy of both parents' most recent federal income tax form 1040 required. Transcript, ACT or SAT, GPA, and counselor's report required also.
Steve Harper Memorial Scholarship	April 15 2010	\$1,000	High school <b>senior</b> planning to attend a Kansas college or university and majoring in photography or natural resources curriculum.
Transition Into Post-Secondary Studies Scholarship	April 15 2010	\$1,000	High school <b>senior</b> who plans to seek an association or bachelor's degree. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, an IEP or 504 Plan. Finalist will be required to participate in an interview.
Ed Wynn Memorial Scholarship Fund	April 16 2010	\$2,000	High school <b>senior</b> with good character and no criminal background. Applicant must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and a dependant of an active police officer, fire fighter or emergency service personnel. Applicants must submit a 750 word essay, two letters of recommendation and transcript.
Student-View Scholarship	April 22 2010	\$500 - \$4,000	An online application for high school <b>seniors</b> . No minimum SAT/ACT score or GPA required. Awards via a random drawing. Log on at <a href="http://www.student-view.com">www.student-view.com</a> .
Shelter Insurance Foundation Scholarship	April 30 2010	\$1,500	Scholarship will be awarded to one graduating Olathe South senior who will be enrolled in college the fall of 2010. Morning Grange #227 Scholarship	June 15 2010	\$1,000	For <b>senior</b> students from Olathe, Gardner, and Spring Hill. Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Activities, awards, and community service considered. Must be a full-time student pursuing an undergraduate degree or attend a vocational or trade school. Scholarship is renewable.
Wichman Family Nursing Scholarship	June 15 2010	Varies	<b>Senior</b> who plans to attend Johnson County Community College and pursue an RN degree. Applicant must be a full time student and have a 2.5 GPA. Student must demonstrate financial need and include a copy of the student's and family's 1040 tax return.
Abbott and Fenner Scholarship	June 19 2010	\$1,000	Scholarship is available to high school <b>juniors and seniors</b> . Applicants must submit an 500 - 1000 word essay on the following topic "What do you see as the long term impact of our current recession on the average family? How might it affect your future decisions?"
BigSun Scholarship	June 24 2010	\$500	Senior athletes are eligible for this award, regardless of which sport you participate in. Applicants need to send a short essay answering "How has your participation in sports affected the person you are becoming?" AES Engineers Scholarship	Oct. 6 2010	\$500	Essay scholarship for <b>senior</b> students. An essay of no more than 1000 words answering one of the two assigned questions.
